He was born July 17, 1865 in Nansemond County, Virginia. He graduated from Richmond College and The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He served for 31 years as pastor of First Baptist Church, Tampa (1905-1936) and when he went to the church in 1905 they had 346 members and when he died on September 3, 1936, they had 2,550 members. Duke was a church builder to be remembered and appreciated.

All three were on the same Southern Baptist Convention program when the convention met in Saint Louis.
